

Syllabus of Entrance Examination

The syllabus of the entrance examination is same as the New Syllabus of IAS Prelims Exam is given as following :-

Section – I (General Studies- 100 Marks)

- Current events of National and International Importance
- History of India and Indian National Movement
- Indian and World Geography- Physical, Social, Economic
- Geography of India and the World
- Indian Polity and Governance- Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.
- Economic and Social Development– Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives etc.
- General Issues on Environmental Ecology, Bio-Diversity and Climate Change that do not require subject specialization
- General Science

Section – II (CAST- 100 Marks)

- Comprehension
- Interpersonal skills including communication skills
- Logical reasoning and Analytical Ability
- Decision making and Problem solving
- General mental ability
- Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude etc.) (Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc. – Class X level)
- English language comprehension skills (Class X level)

Note- 1 :- Section- II will be a qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33%

Note- 2 :- The question paper will be of multiple choice, objective type.
